Household sorting guide

Cardboard and paper packaging

Empty product packaging and packaging materials, fillers, wraps and bags such as milk cartons, biscuit packs, takeaway food containers, disposable cups. Flatten cartons before sorting.

Plastic packaging

Empty product packaging and packaging materials, fillers, wraps, pouches, bottles, jars and bags such as candy wraps, takeaway food containers and disposable cups. All plastic grades also styrofoam. Place caps, lids, pump parts and similar items separately.

Glass packaging

Empty colored and colorless glass packaging such as non-deposit bottles, glassjars. Remove caps and lids. No glass tablewear, porcelain, crystal, window or mirror glass, lamps.

Metal

Empty metal packaging and small metal items such as tins, non-deposit cans, lids, caps, closures, aluminium foil, non-pressurised aerosol cans, metal coffee capsules, pans, nails, screws and cutlery.

Biowaste

Food leftovers, small bones, soft parts of house plants, paper towels and napkins. Pack liquid leftovers such as soups or food oil to cartong packaking. No cigarette ends, diapers, soil, rocks or branches.

Paper

Dry and clean paper such as newspapers, magazines, envelopes, copy and printing papers. Not gift wrapping paper or paper bags.

Mixed waste or combustible waste

Non-recyclable waste to energy. Such as dirty waste textiles, light bulbs, decorative items, household items, hygiene products. No hazardous waste or products under producer responsibility such as electronic equipments, batteries or chemicals.

Take hazardous waste and waste under producer responsibility for free to waste station Ouluntie 57a. Take construction waste, furniture, large sized waste etc. to waste statition for a fee. Garden waste and branches for free to Säväkäntie 4. Thank you for sorting!
